Genesis, Objective and Scope

Asian School of Management and Technology (ASMT) is a global initiative in the field of research & development on social sciences & humanities and on their interaction with other sciences and technologies. The school acts as an international arbiter, bringing different parties together and works as a clearinghouse of knowledge and information. This entails providing information services, constructing international networks and setting up cooperative education, training, projects and research programmes. In collaboration with Brown Walker Press, USA, the school publishes a number of the peer-reviewed journals both in the form of online and paperback edition, which reflect the clearinghouse function of the coalition.

Guidelines to Authors

All articles in ASMT Journal are published in English biannually in Spring and Autumn. Manuscript must be typed in Microsoft Word (*Times New Roman with 12 font size, 1.5 line spacing, 1" both sides margin and British spelling throughout*). No manuscript should ordinarily exceed twenty typed pages including tables, graphs, figures, notes and references. The title, author(s) including affiliation, correspondence and e-mail address, abstract (not exceeding 250 words), and acknowledgements, if any should be clearly specified in the first page of the manuscript. Notes should be circumvented if possible, but while necessary must be put at the bottom of the text (endnotes) followed by a complete list of references used. The contributors should ensure that they are not infringing copyright. Submission of a manuscript implies that it contains unpublished original work and is not being considered for publication elsewhere.

References must be cited in unnumbered alphabetical order as follows:

Each table/graph/figure should be marked in the text in numerical order with suitable caption. No scanned tables, figures, graphs etc. are acceptable in the article. Tables and figures may be inserted either in the text or in the appendices.

Electronic submission of manuscript is acceptable. Electronic version of the manuscript must be submitted directly to the Honorary Editor of the journal followed by a copy to Series Editor.

It should be as brief as possible and concise. It should be complete, self-explanatory, and not require reference to the paper itself. The abstract should be informative giving the scope and emphasizing the main conclusions, results,*

or significance of the work described. Do not use the first person; do not include mathematical expressions; do not use references and try to avoid acronyms.

Submission Preparation Checklist

As part of the submission process, authors are required to check off their submission in compliance with all of the following items, and submissions may be returned to authors that do not adhere to these guidelines.

- The submission has not been previously published, nor is it before another journal for consideration (or an explanation has been provided in Comments to the Editor).
- The text adheres to the stylistic and bibliographic requirements outlined in Guidelines to Authors.
- The submission file includes preferably lower version of Microsoft Word file format (e.g., Microsoft Word 2000-2003, however if upgraded version is used; then save the file in lower version of Microsoft Word).
- If submitting to a peer-reviewed section of the journals, the instructions in ensuring a blind review (at least by 2 reviewers) have been followed.

Author/Editor Open Access Option

Authors can ask ASMT to make their articles accepted for publication available online and openly accessible to them without any restriction except use for commercial purposes. This means that authors may access, read, download or print out their online article at free of charge. Editors of the journal can access full online text of every issue of their journal. However, reprints of article and paperback edition of journal issues may be ordered at a special price directly to the publisher.
